



### Educational attainment of SSI recipients, by age group, December 2010





### Living situation of SSI recipients, by age group, December 2010





### Housing type of SSI recipients, by age group, December 2010





# Household receipt of other benefits among SSI recipients, by age group, December 2010





### SSI payments as a percentage of personal income, by age group, Sept.-Dec. 2010





### Other sources of personal income among SSI recipients, by age group, Sept.-Dec. 2010





- 37 percent of the 65 and older's family income

### Family income relative to poverty threshold, Sept.-Dec. 2010

	Under 100%	100-149%	150% or more
Not Including SSI	65.3	11.8	23
Including SSI	42.8	21.8	35.4

- Including SSI reduces poverty by 1/3
- Does not measure behavioral impact of SSI
- Poverty is reduced from
  - 58 percent to 32 percent for children
  - 67 percent to 44 percent for adults
  - 67 percent to 48 percent for aged
