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MEDICAID's Role – Culture of Health

- Largest Public Insurer
 - Low income and medically vulnerable families
 - Facile accommodates changing needs
- Health care as entry point for more comprehensive responses to address social determinants of health
- Medicaid as partner, not piggybank

COVERAGE

- Facilitate enrollment/access
- Continuity of coverage

Benefits / Payment Reform

- Health / Long Term Services and Support
- Goal: Children ready for school, adult able to work, persons with disabilities supported in community
- Better align federal health nutrition, housing, social supports
- More experimentation / fast track approval for health improvement demonstrations
- Support Medicaid's unique role safety net; populations for whom English is not primary language
