


Regional Variations in the End-of-Life Expenditure Index (EOL-EI) and average per-capita Medicare spending



EOL-EI highly correlated (r = 0.81) with average per-capita Medicare spending



Relative Profitability across DRGs Cardiac DRGs




Potential Medicare Payment Modifications

- Skilled Nursing Facilities (MedPAC, June 2008)
 - Therapy payments based on need not use
 - Non-therapy ancillaries payments based on need
- Imaging Services (MedPAC, Jan. 2009)
 - Payments more closely tied to actual equipment costs
- Home Health Services (MedPAC, Jan. 2009)
 - Risk sharing of profits and losses










Variation in FEHBP Physician and Hospital Fees Across MSAs
