### ABOUT THE RECIPIENTS OF THE 2021 ROBERT M. BALL AWARD



**ROBERT “BOB” GREENSTEIN** has dedicated his life to strengthening social insurance and other programs that enhance economic security. Bob’s leadership built the Center on Budget and Policy Priorities (CBPP), which he founded in 1981 and led through 2020, into a major force for helping shape federal and state policy on public programs, from Medicaid to Unemployment Insurance to Social Security and more. Thanks to his leadership and CBPP’s impactful work, millions of low and moderate-income Americans have benefited from evidence-based policymaking.



**KILOLO KIJAKAZI** has been at the forefront of addressing economic and social issues affecting people of color and women, including structural racism and racial and gender wealth gaps. Kijakazi became Deputy Commissioner for Retirement and Disability Policy at the Social Security Administration (SSA) in January 2021, bringing her expertise on social insurance and retirement policy to lead the department’s policy development and research activities. In July 2021, Kijakazi was named Acting Commissioner of SSA by President Biden.
